* GNI/PPP per Capita, 2000 (\$US) is the gross national income (GNI) in purchasing power parity(PPP) divided by midyear population. GNI/PPP refers to income converted to *international dollars* using purchasing power parity conversion factors. International dollars indicate the amount of goods and services one could buy in the United States with a given amount of money. Data are from the World Bank, *World Development Indicators*, 2002. Italics indicate data for 1998 or 1999.
